This includes well-known columns such as "Heard on the Street" from expert commentators with deep analysis on key market topics which are regularly read and appreciated by market players and are an essential part of their daily workflow. The Reuters Breakingviews commentary service is much smaller and is more opinion-based and less analytical in approach.
- Dow Jones provides a rolling "Market Talk" market comments feature within its standard service, providing ongoing commentary from market insiders. Reuters offers only a limited market comments service via IFR which is sold as a chargeable add-on service, focused on a limited number of asset classes.
- **Dow Jones news is platform-independent.** Reuters news is only available over Thomson Reuters platforms.

Dow Jones strengths against Bloomberg news

- **Dow Jones produces substantially more financial news than Bloomberg** with around 19,000 total items on an average business day, compared to a claimed 6,000 from Bloomberg.
- **Dow Jones adds value through commentary, comment and analysis** within its news stories. Bloomberg typically focuses on the facts only.
- Dow Jones achieves a significant number of beats and scoops through its Newswires and Wall Street Journal journalists and its exclusive real-time access to market-moving news from The Wall Street Journal, Barron's and other Dow Jones publications.
- **Dow Jones provides a rolling "Market Talk" feature** within its standard service with on-going commentary from market insiders. Bloomberg has no equivalent service; Dow Jones Market Talk is a feature which is much appreciated by Bloomberg users.
- **Dow Jones news is platform-independent.** Bloomberg news is only available over the Bloomberg platform (and a very small selection via Bloomberg consumer news sites).
